Are you looking for a great place to start in full-time ministry? With a lead pastor who takes the time to mentor staff members? A vibrant, multicultural congregation that is loving and supportive towards their pastors? Somewhere large enough to have a critical mass for individual ministries, but small enough to gain a wide breadth of ministry experience? South Shore Community Church may be the place for you!

South Shore Community Church is a vibrant, multi-cultural church in Greenfield Park, a historically English neighbourhood in the suburbs of Montreal. (You don't need to be bilingual to live here!) Over the last five years we've had a full-time pastor overseeing a growing student ministry that impacts young people both within the church and from our community.

Key Requirements:

- A growing relationship with God, with openness to the work of the Spirit
- A love for people (especially young people)!
- Credentials with the Pentecostal Assemblies of Canada (or in process of getting them)
- A team-worker with desire to learn and grow throughout life
- Initiative & diligence
- Oral & written communication skills
- Computer skills

Primary Responsibilities:

- Develop and directly lead ministry programs for youth (grades 6-11). These programs should provide a balance of worship, discipleship, and outreach, through both large gatherings and small groups as appropriate.
- Oversee, recruit, and develop leaders for both children and youth ministries.
- Disciple students as appropriate outside of programs, including those in CEGEP (ie. grade 12) and university.
- Support parents in their efforts to disciple their kids.
- Ensure policies for protection of minors and vulnerable adults are followed (ie. Plan to Protect).
- Work with the lead pastor to ensure appropriate pastoral leadership is provided to all areas of the church (based on your abilities).
